
Cheverly Day 2006: Writing Contest

Message from the Chief Buddy Robshaw

The Cheverly Police Department is proud to announce the addition of Lieutenant Joseph Frohlich to the force. Lt. Frohlich is a thirty-year veteran of the Prince George's County Police and brings exceptional experience in all aspects of patrol and investigation. He is very familiar with Cheverly, is a longtime resident of the area, and will certainly enhance the ability and professionalism of this department. Please take a moment to welcome Lt. Frohlich when you see him.



I would like to thank everyone who attended the first **Chief's Advisory Committee / Neighborhood Watch Meeting** on September 21. A wide range of topics were discussed at this meeting, including, the current state of crime in Cheverly and Prince George's County, the goals of the police department in the coming year, the needs and strengths of a community/police partnership, and the importance of accurate and timely information sharing. There were a number of good ideas presented by residents who attended as well as insightful discussions on current problems. **Our next meeting date is Wednesday, October 26, 2005, at 7:30 PM.**

Please contact my office as soon as possible if you have occasion to call for police service but are unable to receive an adequate response. This is of particular importance if you dial **the non-emergency number of 301-333-4000.** This number goes directly to the Prince George's County, Combined Public Safety Communications, the facility that dispatches Cheverly police units.

Several residents have recently found reason to complain about animal violations (loud barking, animals running loose, etc.) only to be rebuffed when attempting to contact the Prince George's County, Combined Public Safety Communications. The county does not typically dispatch police officers (including the Cheverly Police) for animal complaints and residents therefore may not receive timely police response to these calls. As an alternative, residents are encouraged to call the Cheverly Police Department, Monday through Friday, from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM, at (301) 773-8362. Although

this department will only respond to residents who identify themselves that information will remain confidential and this department will subsequently investigate these violations.

The police department is currently planning a series of education/training seminars and workshops for residents on a wide range of topics. Some topics would include basic criminal and traffic law for the layman, home safety and burglary prevention, and understanding code enforcement. These seminars are planned for the winter months and will be well advertised. If there are other topics that may be of interest to you, please feel free to call my office or come to the next Advisory Board/Neighborhood Watch meeting.

The police department currently maintains a wide array of computer equipment and software. Some of these applications are specific, such as our records management system, and others are generic to any business application. In addition, the Town has recently purchased a Web page package. There is currently not an IT person within the department and I suspect we may not be conducting business as efficiently as possible. If there is any person(s) in the community that has expertise with software and general business applications, and would like to donate some time maybe auditing our current system, please feel free to contact me at your convenience. My telephone number is 301-773-8362.

Halloween is on Monday, October 31, 2005. "Trick-or-Treating" is scheduled from 6:00 to 8:00 PM. There will be extra police patrols on the streets that night and we are encouraging "Trick-or-Treaters" of all ages to use extra caution when crossing roadways or walking in the street. In addition, I am requesting that all residents activate as much exterior lighting as possible and to accompany your children to ensure their safety. **On this night only, from 5:00 PM to 9:00 PM, report any complaints or suspicious circumstances directly to the Cheverly Police at (301) 773-8362.** An officer will be on duty to take you calls during this time period and dispatch directly to officers in the field.

This approaching holiday season, don't lose your license to impaired driving. Did you know that your license can be revoked and your car impounded on

the spot when you are arrested for driving while impaired by alcohol or driving while intoxicated. The Cheverly Police Department reminds you that law enforcement will be cracking down in the coming months on impaired drivers. Driving under the influence of alcohol or drugs is a serious crime, a crime that will cost you money, your car, and your license. The choice is yours – designate a sober driver or one will be appointed for you. Remember: You Drink & Drive, You Lose.

If you have a vehicle that you would like to donate for tax purposes, or if you have a vehicle you want removed at no cost, please contact the Cheverly Police Department. This department is currently looking for some vehicles that could be used for investigative work. Do not hesitate to call (301) 773-8362.

Finally, take the time to check the expiration date on all of your vehicle's registration plates. The Cheverly Police Department regularly enforces these violations by way of a summons, impoundment, or both. Unregistered vehicle owners can be fined and their vehicles impounded regardless of whether the vehicle(s) is on public or private property.

NATIONAL SEX OFFENDER PUBLIC REGISTRY

Last month the Justice Department unveiled the National Sex Offender Public Registry (nsopr.gov), which directly links to individual state databases—24 so far. Residents can go the site to get a list of registered sexual offenders living in the area.

LEAF COLLECTION PROCEDURES



Vacuum Leaves: Every street in Cheverly is scheduled for at least 2 vacuuming sweeps.

- Rake leaves between the curb and sidewalk - not on the street or sidewalk.
- Keep leaves free of twigs, branches, metal, concrete and other debris that can jam or damage the equipment.
- Please do not park cars on the street on the assigned collection day.

Bag Leaves: Yard waste is collected on **MONDAYS**. Put bags at the curb on Sunday evening. Use **CLEAR PLASTIC BAGS** only (sold at Town Hall-\$5 for 50 bags). Yard waste includes leaves, grass, brush, twigs, etc. Do not put any dirt, rocks, or other trash/debris in these bags.
